We were treated to a wonderful first week of the finals last weekend and it's hard to go past the epic encounter at McLean Park between Denmark-Walpole and Albany.

It was one of the best games I've seen in several years of footy down here and wouldn't have looked out of place on grand final day.

Two teams having a red-hot crack, quality players everywhere and a great spectacle from start to finish.

Any final where the lead changes 17 times and the margin is never greater than nine points is a worth the price of admission.

The Albany Sharks continued their historic season as they got up in a pulsating final term.

Being boundary side for that final quarter, Sharks coach Jamie Ramm kept reminding his players to take the game on and run against a tiring Magpies outfit.

They had to kick a goal to win the game and Zac Pearson took a fantastic contested mark to do just that.

However there was more drama to come as the determined Magpies took the ball inside 50 one final time and star forward Ash McGrath marked to give them a chance to get back in front. His shot from 40m out directly in front was off target, a goal that may have sunk the Sharks, and in the dying moments Jesse Barrett marked and goaled from close range to hand the Sharks a thrilling eight-point win.

Both sides walked off knowing they had gave everything and the Sharks are worthy of their place in a preliminary final.

From where they have come from to where they are today, it's a wonderful story of persistence.

Regardless of the result, Sunday's final was simply good for footy in the Great Southern – we haven't had a game of that calibre in some time.

Royals showed on Saturday that they are still raging premiership favourites, with a typical hard-nosed display against Railways in the second semifinal.

The Lions will now rest up for a week and that will be crucial given they missed Jayson Ford with a shoulder injury and lost Declan McNamara (knee) and Brayden Parker (hamstring) in the 52-point thumping of the Tigers.

The reigning premiers were wayward in front of goals and it could have been a bloodbath had they kicked straighter but nonetheless they are through to their third straight grand final.

The Tigers were disappointing, let down by poor foot skills and their inability to counter the Lions midfield depth.

It has to be a quick response from the Tigers as they face a Sharks outfit that are playing with confidence and riding the emotional high of the last few weeks.

The Tigers will no doubt make some changes and the return of Zak Hortin and Matt Van Schayk will be critical to how their side sets up in the front half.

A team that has plenty of finals experience, a return to the home ground that they play so well and the burning memory of last year's preliminary final exit is the reason I'll be siding with the Tigers.

They must contain a couple of the Sharks most important players and need to win the midfield battle if they are to get another crack at the Lions.

It promises to be another ripping contest, as two quality teams put their season on the line.  $\bullet$

# Thrilling three-way tie in colts fairest and best award

For just the second time in history, there has been a three-way tie in the Rod Gillies Medal as Toby Hall, Ryley Valli and Jack Stephens shared the honour as the Great Southern Football League's fairest and best colts players on Tuesday.

Railways pair Hall and Stephens, and Royals' Valli, became the first three-way winners of the medal since 2003, after they all finished with 15 votes in the count.

Marcus Wettenhall, Tim Cowley and Warwick Durack were the last players in a three-way tie.

After 10 rounds, Stephens hit the front on 14 votes, while Valli was on 12 and Hall was back on 10.

Valli polled three votes in round 11 to take the lead, before Stephens levelled up again heading into the final round after polling one vote in round 14.

Hall collected two votes in round 14 to be three votes behind the leading pair.

A three-vote performance from Hall in the final game left the three tied at the top after the 15-round regular season. The trio finished ahead of Royals midfielder Cooper Childs (14 votes) and Albany's Mitch Collier (12).

Valli, who won the Warrick Proudlove Medal last year, played league in the last four rounds and finished with three best-afield games in 2021.

"It's pretty humbling seeing I only played 10 games but a lot of hard work went into my season so it's good reward at the end of the year," he said.

"I thought after the Kulin Carnival I played pretty well in my four games, and before that I thought I had a pretty good season as well."

Hall played nine colts matches for three best-on-ground performances.

"I didn't think I was going to get the votes in that game but turns out I did; I think I might have got a bit lucky but that's footy," he said.

"It's pretty cool to win the fairest and best, I think a lot of the boys were deserving of it but I was lucky enough to come away with it." Stephens polled three votes in four games and finished runner-up in the goal kicking with 50 majors.

"It means quite a bit to be recognised as the fairest and best. It was a great year with Railways boys and Rod Gillies is quite a dedicated man in the GSFL," he said.

"I thought I went all right but I didn't think I would get any-where near the top."

Earlier in the night young Lions talent Teague Valli was rewarded for his stellar year, edging out Albany's Shane Ugle by three votes in a tight finish to the Warrick Proudlove Medal for the best sixteens player.

The pair were locked together going into the final round before a best-afield display helped the Lions midfielder prevail on 27 votes, following in the footsteps of his older brother.

"Means a fair lot, especially since my brother Ryley won it last year," Teague said.

"I did think I kind of had a good game in the final round and could get a few votes. I was expecting maybe a vote but I wasn't really sure." •

# 2021 Kleeman Medal



Royals midfield star **Cameron Allison** won his first Kleemann Medal after being rewarded for his brilliant season in the 63rd edition of the prestigious count on Thursday night at Retravision Stadium.

Allison had five votes after the first five rounds of the count before he trailed leader Jayden Woods by a single vote after 10 rounds.

From there the dominant Lion took over and he held an unassailable lead going into the final round, where he polled two votes to seal the medal triumph.

Allison finished with 22 votes to defeat Woods (16 votes) and Kane Shephard (14).
