Round 8 was a big one, some huge scores coming through the results as the stakes continue to be raised.

The double header at Railways was played in 31 degrees with no wind, and no one could argue the conditions were perfect for footy (I think the men's leagues are getting jealous). Royals took on home ground rivals Sharks in a match up that both teams always enjoy. Unfortunately for the Sharks, the Lions were on fire from the first bounce, and despite an early and definitive goal from Steph Grant in the first term, the rest of the game belonged to Royals as the goal kicking onslaught continued all game, the final score of 11.6.72 to 1.1.7 the biggest gap of the season so far.

Staying at Tigerland and the Tigers themselves also made a statement in their game against Mount Barker Bulls. Running in numbers and shutting down the forward 50 as has become their calling card, the Railways girls dominated with the footy over the whole ground. The Bulls maintained the pressure on the all through the middle of the ground for the whole ground, a credit to the resilience of the players, as the score opened up. Railways finished an 8th game undefeated, 7.9.51 o 0.2.2 in front of their home crowd.

Over at Mclean Park, Denmark played the first of 3 home games and welcomed North Albany in the nest as they continued a winning streak that certainly has the Magpie supporters up and about! North Albany were caught napping in the first quarter, with the fired up Maggies coming out hard and fast in front of their home crowd. entering the first term with 2 unanswered majors. The game remained in the Magpies favour as their midfield to stop the well-known run and carry style game of the Kanga's, kicking another major in the second term and meeting half time with the Kanga's only having kicked 2 points. North Albany never fail to bring out the big guns in the 'premiership quarter' however and a late run at the score board had the crowd up and about, the game finishing in Magpies favour 4.1.25 to 2.2.14 with the visitors heading home more than aware that Denmark Walpole is a force to be reckoned with. •
