Welcome back footy fans! I don't know about you guys, but that break was a tough 2 weeks!! Here we are, stepping into the very last game of the 2021 GSFLW home and away season. Easter provided everyone with a well earned chance to recharge, the wounded were carried from the battlefield and allowed some respite; and the coaches, volunteers, and supporters have no doubt been frantically analysing the ladder to piece together their team's chances at making finals in the coming weeks. The beauty of a mid-season break of course is that it gives everyone a chance to take stock, and come into the last round with only 1 thing on their minds – finals.

Round 9 was an all too familiar emotional roller coaster – bringing with it the kinds of ups and downs we've become accustomed to in this league, with no team EVER taking anything for granted. The week itself was an odd one, with Basketball Grand Finals being played on the Friday night causing some logistical nightmares for our cross code players. North Albany coach Fiona Mountford achieved the borderline impossible task of rescheduling a game to the Thursday night, taking on Royals at Centennial Oval. Aside from the impressive scheduling success, also worth noting was the spectator attendance at this game despite the fact that it was played on Thursday, and moved on very short notice; we love how much you guys love your footy! Royals held the Kangaroos goalless for the duration of the game, with North only managing a point in the final term despite constant pressure on the ball. The Lions struggled with some accuracy in front of goal, however midfielder Kat Jennings opened up the scoreboard with a straight kick in the first quarter, 1 of 2 majors for the game. No-one would suggest the win came easy as North Albany's power in the middle of the field, through the likes of Holly and Kate Minter, and Laura Archer, had the Lions

players working hard all game; Royals finishing 2.5.17 to 0.1.1.

The game that everyone has been talking about was held out at McLean oval, where, in a HUGE upset, the Denmark Walpole Magpies managed to defeat the otherwise unbeaten Tigers in an awesome display of football. Denmark came out absolutely firing, kicking 2 unanswered majors in the first term and no doubt causing the most intense quarter time chat for the Tigers so far this season. Railways, missing a couple of their midfield powerhouses to the basketball, have not made it to almost certain minor premiers by luck, and corrected their game quickly in the second term, kicking 1 goal 1 and clawing their way back to a 12-point deficit. The damage was done however, and this was as close as they got. Denmark didn't take their foot off the pedal all game, with Liza Alkins having a cracking game, and their relentless attack on the ball resulting in them finding 2 more goals and an impressive and well earned win. 4.2.26 to the Tigers 2.2.14 and I can vouch for the fact that the Denmark crowd could be heard cheering from Albany.

Back in Albany at Centennial Oval, the Mount Barker Bulls travelled to take on the Albany Sharks on their home turf. Both teams having a difficult end to the season with injuries taking a toll on their squads, the game was a make or break for the Sharks as they fought for a chance to play finals. Sharks were on the board first and led for the duration of the game, with impressive full forward Steph Grant, remaining accurate in front of goals. Mount Barker fought valiantly, kicking a major in the first quarter, however that was to be their only goal for the game as the Sharks defending 6 meticulously shut them down in the forward 50. The result was an important one for Sharks, securing them 4th place on the ladder and a shot at the semi-finals next week. Albany 3.6.24 to Mount Barker 1.4.10. •
